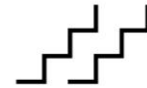


# Regulations for Transfer from the 3rd Class of the Monolingual Progymnasium to the Upper School of the Gymnasium

## 1 Transfer to the Upper School of the Gymnasium of Freies Gymnasium Zürich

- 1.1 Students from the 3rd class can qualify for transfer to any of the study profiles of the upper school of the Gymnasium, with the exception of the classics profile.
- 1.2 At the end of the 3rd quarter of the 3rd class, students receive a transfer report instead of the usual mid-term report. This report is decisive regarding transfer to the upper school of the Gymnasium.
  - 1.2.1 The transfer report is based on the student's performance in the second and third quarters.
- 1.3 The following subjects are decisive for transfer:
  - German (50% oral, 50% written)
  - French
  - English
  - Arithmetic and Algebra
  - Geometry
  - History / Civic Education
  - Geography
  - Natural Sciences
  - ArtAll these subjects receive equal weighting.
  - 1.3.1 The mark for Natural Sciences is made up as follows:
    - From the 2nd quarter: Physics (1/2 of the mark)
    - From the 3rd quarter: Chemistry practical work (or Physics practical work) (1/2 of the mark)
  - 1.3.2 The mark for Art is made up as follows:
    - Visual Arts or Music (according to subject choice)
  - 1.3.3 The mark for History is made up as follows:
    - From the 2nd quarter: History (1/3 of the mark)
    - From the 3rd quarter: History and Civic Education (each 1/3 of the mark)
- 1.4 In order to transfer to the upper school of Freies Gymnasium Zürich, students must achieve an average mark of at least 4.75 in the above subjects in the transfer report.
- 1.5 Students who achieve an average mark of 4.65 to 4.74 in the above subjects in the transfer report can transfer to the upper school of Freies Gymnasium Zürich with a probationary period lasting until the end of the first term.



1.6 Following transfer to the upper school of Freies Gymnasium Zürich, students are subject to the promotion regulations of the Gymnasium. As a rule there is no probationary period.

## **2 Transfer to the Gymnasium of Other Schools**

2.1 Students who attempt and fail the entrance examination of another Gymnasium outside Freies Gymnasium Zürich are not, as a rule, eligible for admission to the upper school of Freies Gymnasium Zürich in the same school year. This applies even when the students have qualified for transfer to the upper school of Freies Gymnasium Zürich.

## **3 Decision-making Powers**

3.1 Decisions regarding promotion and transfer are made by the convention of all the subject teachers for the individual class.

3.2 In certain well-founded cases, the convention of subject teachers may decide to act at variance with the regulations listed under articles 1.4 and 1.5.

## **4 Appeal**

4.1 The contract partner has the right to appeal in writing to the appropriate Head of Department against decisions affecting a student, based on these promotion regulations, in the event that substantial pertinent facts that were unknown to the convention of teachers can be taken into account.

4.2 Should the appeal be authorised, the convention of teachers has the power of decision.

4.3 Should the decision of the convention of teachers remain unchanged despite the appeal, the contract partner has the right to appeal to the School Governors. The decision of the School Governors is final.

## **5 Coming into Effect**

These transfer regulations come into effect for the 2010/2011 school year.
