Freies Gymnasium Zürich was the first school in the canton to found a bilingual Progymnasium in collaboration with Lakeside School (Küsnacht). This built a bridge between genuine bilingual primary school education and the upper school of the Gymnasium, and marked a pioneering achievement in truly bilingual education in the Canton of Zurich.

The bilingual way

The bilingual way at FGZ offers a programme that is taught with equal amounts of German and English, each at mother-tongue level. As a result, pupils are successfully immersed in the culture of both languages. In order to meet the requirements of a

globalised world, the bilingual way at FGZ is not limited to just a few school years, but begins at Pre-Kindergarten level and is concluded with the Swiss Bilingual Matura examination (which is on a par with the International Baccalaureate IB), and qualifies students to study at Swiss and international universities. Teaching is based on the Zurich curriculum.

Primary school classes are the responsibility of our partner, the Lakeside School, in Küsnacht. The Progymnasium, the lower and upper schools of the Gymnasium, are the responsibility of FGZ.
